I. Enabling Statute or Proviso

Powers of the University's Board of Directors to fix tuition and other charges for students attending the college are allowed per SC Code of Laws 59-133-30 regarding powers of the Board. Powers to fix University Fees by the Board are further described per Proviso 117.11. All revenue from fines and fees are collected under the provisions and requirements of Proviso 117.8 which allows select agencies to collect and retain revenue and income from student fees.
