NCAA Compliance Committee

MEMBERSHIP

The NCAA Compliance Committee shall consist of the Compliance Director, Chair; the Director of Admissions (or designee); the Assistant Director of Financial Aid (or designee); the Registrar (or designee); the Faculty Athletics Representative; the Senior Woman Administrator; and the Director of Athletics.

FUNCTION

The committee exists to ensure the institution's compliance with all rules, regulations, and guidelines of the National Collegiate Athletic Association. The committee is responsible for determining that all applicable rules and regulations of the NCAA are followed in the institution's conduct of its intercollegiate athletics program. It will monitor all programs to assure compliance and to identify and report to the NCAA instances in which compliance has not been achieved. In addition the committee will review all new rules, eligibility of returning student-athletes and processes during its June meeting. In its September meeting will review all polices and procedures for recruitment documentation and monitoring. The committee is responsible for determining compliance on the part of institutional staff, student-athletes, and other individuals and groups that represent the institution's athletic interests, ensuring compliance with all applicable NCAA rules.

PROCEDURES

The committee meets once during the fall semester, once during the spring semester, and once during the summer to perform its function as stated above.

The committee reports to the Director of Athletics.
