Policy for the Naming of Facilities

It is the prerogative of the Trustees to authorize the naming of buildings and facilities to honor individuals whose service or actions merit distinctive recognition. Traditionally, individuals have been deemed worthy of this honor through satisfying one or more of the following criteria:

- 1) Public service to the community, state or nation;
- 2) Philanthropic giving to the university or foundation;
- 3) Service to the university or its constituents.

Accordingly, the Board will continue to be guided by these criteria as adopts the following policy for all future naming initiatives.

Major buildings will be named upon recommendation of the President and the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees and approval by a 2/3 affirmative vote of all Trustees. Portions of buildings or lesser facilities may be named upon the recommendation of the President and approval by a majority of the Executive Committee.
