# Secondary English Teacher Licensure Program Information

## School of Education "Checkpoint" Information

- To be admitted to the Professional Education Program (Checkpoint I), candidates must:
  - o pass all sections of the PRAXIS I/Praxis Core test
  - o possess a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 OR 2.6 (if entered FMU Fall 2014 or Spring 2015).
  - o earn grades of "C" or higher in EDUC 190, EDUC 191, and EDUC 305.
  - o receive satisfactory dispositions recommendations in EDUC 190
- To be approved for Student Teaching (Checkpoint II), candidates must:
  - o pass both the PLT and English Language, Lit., and Composition PRAXIS II tests
  - o possess a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75 OR 2.6 (if entered FMU Fall 2014 or Spring 2015).
  - o earn grades of "C" or higher in all EDUC courses
  - o receive satisfactory Dispositions recommendations in EDUC 313 and EDUC 393
  - o complete a SLED background check <u>and</u> the fingerprinting process. See your advisor or the School of Education at least <u>9 months</u> prior to student teaching for further information.

#### School of Education Course Information

• The following EDUC courses require candidates to complete field experiences in local schools outside of scheduled classes:

- Candidates should enroll in the EDUC 380 section designated for secondary teachers.
- Candidates should enroll in EDUC 393/434 in the Fall semester prior to student teaching.

# Middle-Level "Add-on" Licensure

Secondary English Teacher Licensure majors have the option of adding on a middle-level endorsement (grades 5-8) to their secondary (grades 9-12) licensure. In order to add middle-level licensure, students must complete all requirements for secondary certification in English and take two additional courses: MLE 422 and PSY 316.

# PRAXIS Test Information for Secondary English Teacher Certification Majors

# PRAXIS Core

- Passing scores on all sections of PRAXIS Core tests are required for admission to the FMU Professional Education Program and to take any EDUC course beyond EDUC 305. Work toward fulfilling this requirement as soon as possible.
- Candidates who meet one of the following requirements are exempt from PRAXIS Core:
  - o ACT Composite score of 24 or above <u>OR</u> SAT Reading and Math combined score of 1100 or above <u>OR</u> SAT Reading, Math, and Writing combined score of 1650 or above.
- In order to obtain an exemption, test scores <u>must</u> be confirmed by the SOE office.
- Please note: Candidates must submit an official paper copy of PRAXIS I/Core scores to the SOE.
- PRAXIS Core tests are offered continuously. You can find test center and scheduling information at <a href="http://www.ets.org/praxis">http://www.ets.org/praxis</a>.

### PRAXIS II

- Two PRAXIS II tests are required for Secondary English certification in South Carolina: o Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT): Grades 7-12 Test #5624; passing score: 157 o English Language Arts (ELA): Content & Analysis Test #5039; passing score: 168
- Candidates must pass both required PRAXIS II tests <u>before</u> student teaching. <u>Official examinee copies</u> of PRAXIS II scores must be submitted to the SOE office <u>by Reading Day</u> of the semester prior to student teaching.
- The score submission deadline for student teaching in Fall 2017 is 4/25/17, and the score submission deadline for student teaching in Spring 2018 is 12/5/17.
- Availability for computer-based tests fills up quickly; make a reservation several months in advance.
- The PLT test should be taken following the completion of EDUC 305. The ELA test should be taken at least 6 months before the score submission deadline.
