Admission Requirements & Procedures

Students who wish to undertake graduate study are admitted either as graduate degree students or as graduate non-degree students. While most students are degree-seeking, the provision for non-degree students accommodates those wishing to meet professional requirements to master specific course content without working toward a master's degree. In either case, the Graduate Application for Admission must be submitted if you did not attend the previous regular semester, and the application fee must be paid if it has not previously been paid. Steps for web registration

- Meet with your academic adviser. Your academic adviser will approve you for web registration.
- Web registration will be available beginning April 4, 2018. Student access will be by classification as follows:
Seniors may begin registering on April 4.
Juniors may begin registering on April 6.
Sophomores may begin registering on April 10.
Freshmen may begin registering on April 12.
- Log in on the web to: www.fmarion.edu.
- Click on "Swamp Fox for Students." Click on "Register for Classes."
- Enter User Name – this will be your ID number.
- Enter Password – Your first password will be your birth month and birth date (two digits each).
Examples: January 5 = 0105
December 10 = 1210
- Click on OK.
- At this point if this is your first time using Swamp Fox, you must create a new four digit password. This is your password created and known only to you. So be sure to record it in a safe place. You will need this four digit password for all future transactions. REMEMBER: This password will be known only by you and the Registrar's Office.
- Select the semester for which you wish to register, then click that semester.
- Once you have selected a semester, you are now ready to add or delete classes.

Please note: When you are viewing the class schedule, the number of seats showing are the number of seats available as you are looking at the screen. **You must click on "Finalize My Class Schedule" to be registered for the class.**
