The History Department at Francis Marion University invites applications for a tenure-track position in the history of continental Western Europe. While the subfield is open, preference will be given to those candidates who can teach courses that complement those currently offered by the department. Candidates are expected to have Ph.D. in hand by start of appointment (though ABDs nearing completion of their degree will be considered), teaching experience, and a preparedness to conduct research in his or her field of expertise as well as serve on university committees. Teaching load is 4-3, including both halves of the European history survey.

Francis Marion University is a public institution of about 4,000 students. It is located in Florence, South Carolina, a growing city with a metropolitan population of just over 200,000.
