#### Please read the following important facts about summer assistance.

- It may take up to 2 weeks from the completion of my application for my loan to be approved.
- If I am not making satisfactory academic progress (SAP) after Spring 2024, my summer aid will be canceled.
- I must enroll in a minimum of 6 hours to be eligible for a Federal loan.
- The amount of my financial assistance is based on my remaining loan/Pell grant eligibility and the combined number of hours that I plan to enroll in for the summer.
- If I require an alternative loan, I must complete an alternative loan application under the 'Summer Aid' link under Financial Assistance at www.fmarion.edu.
- I will receive the first disbursement of my summer Federal student loan funds when I have enrolled in and am attending at least six hours. (For example, a student enrolling in 3 hours in Summer I and 3 hours in Summer II.) <u>WILL NOT</u> receive loan funds until <u>Summer II</u>.)
- If I enroll in less than 6 hours in my first summer term, I must pay those fees with my ownfunds.
