FMU, CCU and Media General to sponsor gubernatorial debate

FLORENCE – Gubernatorial candidates Democrat Vincent Sheheen and Republican Nikki Haley will face off just one week before Election Day in a live, televised debate on the Francis Marion University campus.

The debate, which will be broadcast live on WBTW News 13 and on SCNow.com, is scheduled for Tuesday, Oct. 26, at 7 p.m. in Chapman Auditorium. It is part of a series of political forums sponsored by FMU, Coastal Carolina University, WBTW-TV, the *Morning News* and scnow.com.
