Hello everyone,

I just want to send a reminder that painter and printmaker Jonathan Green will give a presentation today at the Nursing Building, room 137 from 2 p.m. - 3 p.m. Green was born in Gardens Corner, South Carolina and grew up in the heart of Gullah culture. Green's art celebrates that culture and his memories of his childhood by imbuing them with color, rhythm, grace and a monumental majesty. He has been recognized with many awards and his artworks have been widely exhibited. In 2005, the Columbia City Ballet presented a ballet inspired by Green's paintings entitled *Off the Wall*. This coincided with a major retrospective of his paintings by the Columbia Museum of Art. Together they were among the high points of the cultural life in Columbia that year.

Green is an engaging speaker and a forceful advocate of the Lowcountry's rice culture. He will be talking this afternoon about his art, his life, and his business, Jonathan Green Studios. Green's talk will be followed by audience Q/A. It's free and open to the public.
