## Attachment A Library Instruction Assessment Report

April 2016

In fall 2015, the reference librarians began to administer assessment to students in classes which had classroom instruction in the library. A short-question multiple choice quiz was designed to review facts presented by the librarian instructor. The quiz was administered in Room 201 at the conclusion of the presentation to all the students in these courses:

- University Life 100 and 102
- English 111, 112, and 200

Between September 3, 2015 and April 18, 2016, 20 classes were given the quiz. A total of 346 students were tested. The distribution was as follows:

| English 200 | 4 | 77 |

The quiz questions were designed to determine if students learned the facts that were presented in the lecture, tour, and web presentation. Questions asked concerned what resources and services the library provides. There was no assessment involving students' abilities to perform a search or other activity.

The grade distribution was as follows:

$91.2 \%$ "passed" with $75 \%$ or $100 \%$.
