Francis Marion University is committed to providing a safe environments for the entire FMU community. Special practices and procedures will be put in place for the Fall 2020 semester.

Francis Marion University is making a slight adjustment to the university’s academic calendar as part of its ongoing effort to conduct fall classes in a safe and responsible manner. The last day of classes for the fall semester is now Wednesday, Nov. 25, the day before Thanksgiving. Previously, the last day of classes was Nov. 30 and Nov. 25 was not a scheduled class day.

This change allows students to travel home and remain with their families throughout the holiday season.

Faculty will have the option of giving final exams in person, prior to the end of classes, or giving exams online during the exam period. Grades will be due as previously scheduled.

Fall commencement is scheduled for December 12, 2020. The university will make adjustments to commencement as necessary, depending upon the safety standards and protocols in place closer to that date.
