


FMU Dual Enrollment Application Tutorial

Step 1: Access the FMU Dual Enrollment application at



Choose your Application Type and Start Your FMU Application

Freshman Students
A freshman student is a first year student, having never previously attended a college or university after graduation from high school.

Dual Credit Students
Francis Marion University offers dual enrollment courses to students in partnering high schools through its Dual Enrollment Program. This program gives qualified students the opportunity to receive college credit for courses while still in high school. Courses are offered at The Continuum, online, and in various partnering high schools.

Transfer Students
Students who have previously attended a college or university after graduation from high school.

Readmission Students
Readmit students are previously enrolled FMU students, who left prior to completing requirements for the degree, and who would like re-enroll for the purpose of completing their degree.

Second Degree Students
Second degree students are individuals who have already been awarded a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution, and who wish to pursue a second bachelor's degree.

Visiting Students
Visiting students are ether students who do not wish to pursue a FMU degree at this time, or who are normally enrolled at another college or university and wish to take course at FMU for transfer back to their home institution. Admission as a visiting student does not automatically guarantee later admission into a degree seeking program.

Exchange Students
Before applying to FMU as an exchange student, you must be nominated by the international programs office of your home university. Please note that incoming exchange students are only admitted for visiting study, for either a semester or an academic year. If you are an international student that is interested in applying to FMU as a full-time, degree-seeking student, please contact our Admissions team directly.
Once you have been nominated to study at FMU as an exchange student, you will be contacted by the international Programs office and asked to begin the formal application process.
Our International Student Guide is updated annually and provides a great place to begin learning about FMU, while you apply.
