




Renewing Aruba Quick Connect Certificates on Android Devices

The instructions below are used to connect any android mobile devices to the FMU network, but it is needed for android devices that are requesting “Domain” address when attempting to connect to FMU wireless network. The Aruba ClearPass QuickConnect app will installed all required configuration files.





<p>Login with FMU Gmail address and Patriot Portal Password.</p> <p>Ex: frank.fox@g.fmarion.edu</p>	




Click to **download** and **Install** the Quick Connect network configuration application


The app should automatically open in the Google Play Store.

If not, go to the Google Play Store, search for **ClearPass QuickConnect**, download, install and open the Quick Connect App.




<p>Click Continue</p>

<p>The app will open a browser, click to download network profile</p>	



Open the downloaded file so it can open in the **ClearPass QuickConnect** app.



Open the network settings and **click FMU**. The eduroam network will be automatically connected
