### A Note On The Runner Stumbles

The Runner Stumbles is based on an actual murder case. In the early 1900's in Traverse City, Michigan, a priest was accused of the murder of a nun. Playwright Milan Stitt heard of the tale from his wife, who had lived in the area. He took these facts and devised events and actions to suit his concept for drama. In the course of preparing the play for Broadway production he went to Traverse City and was jolted by the experience. His first shock came when he read the transcripts of the trial to find six lines of testimony that were identical with the dialogue he had invented for the play. He then went to visit the rectory that had been the scene of the murder. It had remained unchanged since that time, and was exactly the same as the setting he had conceived for his play, down to the design of the wallpaper.
