Mr. Alex Lee is an Associate Actuary at Colonial Life and Accident Insurance in Jacksonville, FL, and is a member of the American Academy of Actuaries and an Associate of the Society of Actuaries. He has nine years of experience in major medical and supplemental insurance industries including business analytics, reserving and valuation, product development and pricing, and most recently forecasting and financial planning. Mr. Lee was a May 2010 graduate of Francis Marion University with a Bachelor of Science in Mathematics (Summa Cum Laude), and was the recipient of the 2010 Francis Marion University Mathematics Award and 2009 Allen Mathematics Scholarship. He also was a Varsity letter winner in Baseball and a 2010 ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American.
