ORIENTATION CHECK-IN 8:30AM – 9:00AM
McNAIR SCIENCE BUILDING LOBBY

Students will have the opportunity to pay their matriculation fee during check-in and may also speak with a Math and/or English placement advisor at this time, if needed.
