



### Connecting to the FMU Wireless Network Using Windows Devices

The instructions below are used to connect and provision any Windows Computer or Laptop to FMU wireless network. The Aruba QuickConnect Application will guide you through the setup process and install all necessary configuration for enhanced security. Contact Campus Technology Help Desk at 843.661.111 if you are experiencing difficulty logging in after following the below steps.

Connect to the **FMU-Guest** WI-Fi or connect using an **ethernet cable**.

Once connected, the default browser will open automatically to this webpage. If it does not open automatically, go to any known website like [www.google.com](http://www.google.com).

Select **Click Here**.

If this page does **not** load automatically, go to <https://portal.fmarion.edu/>



Login with **FMU Gmail address** and Patriot Portal **Password**.

Username must be your full email address that contains @fmarion.edu, or @g.fmarion.edu




Click on the White button to download the QuickConnect configuration application

Once downloaded, double-click to open the file – the name should be **ArubaQuickConnect.exe**.


The file can also be found in the Downloads folder.




Click **“Close”**

Now, your Windows computer will automatically connect to the **“eduroam”** wireless network

Finally, connect to the **“FMU”** SSID wireless network. Make sure you check the box to connect automatically.

Students will receive an IP of 172.19.xx.xx  
Employees will receive an IP of 10.96.xx.xx



If you tired the above step and it does not connect to the FMU network, it might be that you already went through the provision process before, or the certificate might be expired, so you will need to remove the saved networks.

Go to **Windows Settings**

Click on **“Network & Internet”**

Click **“WI-FI”** on the left tab

Click on **“Manage Known Network”**

**Forget** FMU, FMU\_Guest, or eduroam

**Repeat the configuration process.**
