

Steps to View Your Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Status

Step 1. Once on your Patriot Portal, locate the "Financial Aid" section under "Semester Planning" (Image 1). You may have to scroll in the box to see "Financial Aid". The link will bring you to the Financial Aid Home Page (Image 2).

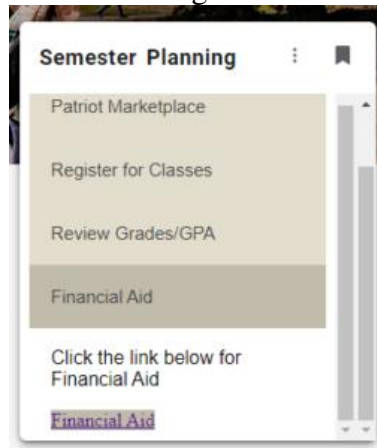
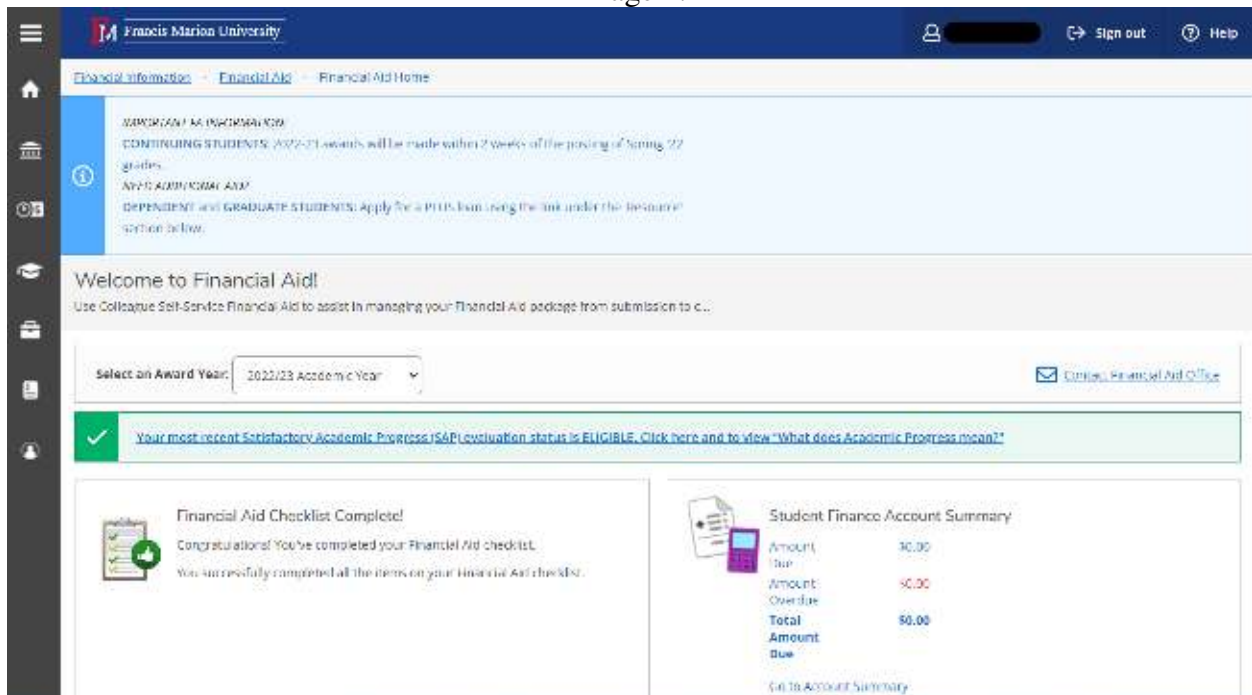

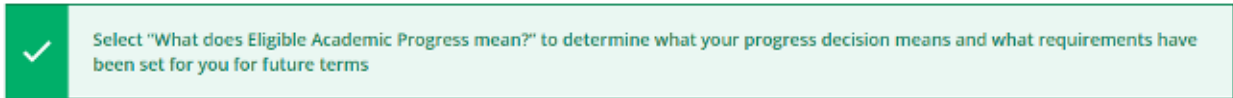
Step 2. Click on the green or red banner that says “Your most recent Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) evaluation status is _____.”



*If you do not have a SAP Banner, this is because your progress has not been evaluated yet. Typically, new freshman students do not have a SAP because it is evaluated at the end of every Spring semester.

The link will bring you to the “Satisfactory Academic Progress” page. This page shows your “SAP Status,” “Cumulative GPA,” “SAP Completion Percentage,” and other information regarding your academic progress.
